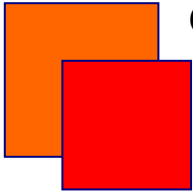

2009 CAMOS Dissertation Award

The Committee for the Analysis of Military Operations and Strategy (CAMOS), an affiliated group of the American Political Science Association, announces its 2009 competition for best doctoral dissertation in the field of strategic studies. The prize will consist of a certificate and \$200 cash award to be presented at the 2009 APSA annual meeting in Toronto.

Criteria for selection include originality, rigor, theoretical contribution, relevance to important policy issues, and power of expression. Consideration will be limited to dissertations that address the conduct, planning, or outcomes of military operations and strategy. Only completed dissertations will be considered. Dissertations completed or defended in the period **June 1, 2007 to May 31, 2009** will be considered for the 2009 prize. The committee reserves the right not to award a prize in a given year.

Eligibility is not limited to political scientists. Appropriate dissertations in history, public policy, public administration, operations research, economics, sociology or other disciplines with an interest in strategic studies will also be considered.

Nominations may be submitted by dissertation authors, committee members, department chairs, or other faculty familiar with the research. Nominations must include a cover letter with the nominee's complete contact information, one paper copy of the complete dissertation, and an electronic file (PDF preferred) with all text and supporting figures or tables.
